Musselshell County is taking the directive from the Governor seriously. In order to continue to serve our community and keep our staff safe, we are instituting, per recommendations by the Governor that county government can follow, skeletal staffing at the courthouse.

Treasurer's Office, Clerk & Records Office and Clerk of District Court, and County Attorney offices are still fully operational. All offices are available by phone during regular business hours. County Attorney will be available 24/7 by phone. All departments in the courthouse will be available for appointment if needed.

Sheriff Lesnik and his deputies are still enforcing the laws 24/7. The Health Department is operating continuously to provide care to our citizens and diminish the spread of COVID-19.

By limiting our activity as directed by the Governor, we limit exposing the public and our exposure to COVID-19 as well.
